



❖ Meet and Greet, transfer from the airport to the hotel and accommodation & Overnight at the Hotel.










#### **TUESDAY FEBRUARY 13th 2024**

DELHI (Old and New Delhi)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- ❖ Delhi, take a private tour of Old Delhi. Tour of the Red Fort area and we will enjoy a ride in Rickshaw (Bicitaxi) in Chandni Chowk, formed by a maze of alleys. You will visit the Raj Ghat (Symbolic Tomb or Memorial of Mahatma Gandhi).









Also visit New Delhi, a modern part of the city built by the English in 1911 as the administrative headquarters of the British Raj. The tour includes the Gateway of Outub Minar, Rashtrapati India: Bhawan, formerly the and today the Presidential Residence Palace, the Embassies area and its main streets and avenues. The visit will conclude with the visit of the Sikh Temple "Bangla Sahib" where you will be able to attend the religious ceremony.











#### **WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 14th 2024**

DELHI - SAMODE - JAIPUR

- ❖ Breakfast at hotel
- ❖ Departure by road to Jaipur, the "Pink City" where the emblematic facade of the Palace of Winds is located. En route visit the Samode palace and enjoy Lunch at the Palace and continue to the city of Jaipur.

Jaipur, also known as the pink city, is the capital of the state of Rajasthan and was founded in 1728 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, ruler of Amber and a great fan of astronomy. Jaipur is a model of a pre-modern city in terms of the regulation of its side streets cut at right angles, which makes this city a marvel.








## THURSDAY FEBRUARY 15th 2024 JAIPUR - AMER - JAIPUR

- Breakfast at hotel
- ❖ We will be driven just outside Jaipur to the ancient capital of Amber to see the fabulous Amber Fort. Maharaja Mansingh, Mughal Emperor Akbar's most successful General, started the construction of Amber Fort in the 17th century. Before the City Palace was constructed in Jaipur, Amber was the seat of power. A Jeep will spare you the trouble of reaching up to the fortress. Once on top, stroll through the sprawling complex of courtyards and halls. Many of the rooms have delightful wall paintings, with precious stones and mirrors inlaid in the walls.










Most fascinating, perhaps, is the Sheesh Mahal (hall of mirrors) where a single lamplight is reflected in the many mirrors, lighting up the room. Come back to your hotel after your excursion.





- Later you will be proceed for city tour of Jaipur. Among the highlights to be seen while touring Jaipur include the City Palace, which is an overwhelming complex of exquisite palaces, gardens and courtyards, decorative art and carved doorways. The palace museum houses collections of rare manuscripts, armoury, costumes, carpets and miniature paintings.
- ❖ Walk to the adjacent Jantar Mantar or Astronomical Observatory made by the Maharaja of Jaipur, built in 1726 and is one of the five such astronomical wonders built by Sawai Jai Singh and makes accurate predictions even to this day. You will stop and see the 'Palace of Winds', otherwise known as Hawa Mahal. It is really an elaborate facade behind which the ladies of the court used to watch the daily goings on in the street below. It is extremely intricate in its pink sandstone carving. The cool wind blows through its facade of windows and latticed screens through which the queens of the court once viewed the streets of the city. You will also have the opportunity to wander about the local markets.

# FRIDAY FEBRUARY 16th 2024 JAIPUR - ABHANERI - FATEHPUR SIKRI - AGRA

- ❖ Breakfast at hotel
- ❖ In the morning, departure by road towards Agra. Visiting Abhaneri en route and its medieval Rajput monuments such as the Chand Baori (well) and the Harshat Mata Temple dedicated to the god Vishnu.










❖ Next we visit Fatehpur Sikri. The history of the city began when Akbar, desperate because he had no heir, decided to visit a holy Muslim man, Salim Chisti, who lived in a small town in Sikri. Akbar changed his capital to Fatehpur Sikri and built several civil buildings such as Diwan-I-Am, Diwan-I-Khas, Jodhabai Palace, Birbal's House, Marian's House and the Panchmahal.










❖ We continue to AGRA, Two great Mughals, Akbar and Shah Jahan, transformed the small village of Agra into the second capital of the Mughal Empire, giving it the name Dar-ul-Khilafat (Emperor's seat). Nowadays, a person who visits Agra will be able to discover endless contrasts when looking at the red stone and white marble buildings.







❖ Arrive and transfer to the hotel. Overnight.



AGRA, the city known for its famous monument of love – the TAJ MAHAL, the most famous monument in India. It is located on the west bank of the Yamuna River, in one of the great plains of northern India. The architectural splendor of the city is reflected in its medieval monuments that were built by the Mughals who ruled India for more than 300 years.








### SATURDAY FEBRUARY 17th 2024 AGRA (TAJ MAHAL & AGRA FORT)

- ❖ Breakfast at the hotel.
- ❖ Early Morning we will visit TAJ MAHAL -- In the 16th and 17th centuries, at the time of the Mughals, Agra was the capital of India. The Taj Mahal, one of the 7 Wonders of the World, built in white marble by Emperor Shah Jahan as a mausoleum for his Queen Mumtaz Mahal, is a universal symbol of love (Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays). Later we will visit the Agra Fort.










Agra Fort-- Construction was originally started by Emperor Akbar in 1565, but his son, Jahangir, and grandson, Shah Jahan, later made additions. It houses the Dewan-e-Khas and Dewan-e-Aam (Halls of Private and Public Audience). Its walls and palaces are a silent witness to the rise and fall of the Imperial Mughal Empire and feature a variety of ingenious Islamic inspired devices (some decorative, some more practical) within the fabric of the buildings.



❖ In the afternoon visit popularly known as Baby Taj or Little Taj Mahal, the Itimad-ud-Daulah Mausoleum, is another of the great references that Agra offers us. Then continue to visit the impressive Mehtab Bagh Gardens. These Persian-style gardens, whose translation means moonlight gardens, are possibly the best vantage point from which to enjoy the silhouette of the colossal Taj Mahal.

### **TUESDAY FEBRUARY 20th 2024**

BANGKOK (THAILAND)



Grand Palace, Wat Pho where the 46.25 meter long Reclining Buddha is located and Wat Traimit with a Buddha of 5.5 tons of weight of pure gold!!!



- ❖ Breakfast at hotel
- ❖ We will start riding a tuk tuk, the most typical means of transportation in Thailand, towards the **Grand Palace** while we contemplate the atmosphere and hectic movement of the city in the morning. The imposing Palace was the former residence of the King of Thailand, built in 1782, this complex of almost 22 hectares, served as the royal court and administrative headquarters of Thailand for 200 years and its houses more than a hundred buildings. Among other points of interest, we will visit the old library and the Wat Phra Kaew, where the **Emerald Buddha** is located: a small Buddha 65cm high, spectacularly ornate, and one of the most important jewels of the country. After it we will visit the **Wat Pho** with the **Reclining Buddha** is located and **Wat Traimit** with a **Buddha of 5.5 tons of weight of pure gold!!!**. Our day ends after those visits so you can continue at your leisure.

\* Bangkok. Damnoen Floating Market and Train Market Saduak. We will do a fantastic tour in a typical traditional boat through the waterways to look how local people live.










- Breakfast at hotel.
- ❖ We will go out by road to meet the train market, where we will discover the products of the local shopping basket and we will look how the market stalls are lifted when the train passes by up to 6 times a day. Then we will move to the Damnoen Saduak floating market, where we will take a panoramic tour in a typical fishing boat long stern through the waterways to witness how they buy from boat to boat, whatever you can imagine. After some leisure, you can do some shopping and we will return to the hotel.

CHIANG RAI - WHITE TEMPLE - BLUE TEMPLE
GOLDEN TRIANGLE - MEKONG RIVER NAVIGATION
VISIT THE OPIUM MUSEUM - MAE SAI

- Breakfast at hotel.
- ❖ Our first stop will be for a tour in a typical 5/15Long stern boat on the Mekong overlooking Laos. We will continue towards the Golden Triangle, where the borders of Laos, Thailand and Myanmar converge; Opium was once cultivated, although today only the museum remains. Our next stop will be Wat Rong Khun or White Temple, a place of Buddhist worship and Hinduism with an unconventional decoration and whose construction, still unfinished, is being carried out with crystals.










❖ Then we will visit the **Blue Temple**, Wat Rong Suea Ten, the work of one of the students of Chalermchai Kositpipat, creator of the previously visited White Temple. We will visit the **Opium museum** and the border town with Burma, Mae Sai. Return to the resort.

### **SATURDAY FEBRUARY 24th 2024**

FROM CHIANG RAI TO CHIANG MAI - AEA THERMAL TIGRES SANCTUARY - GIRAFFE WOMEN TOWN DOI SUTEPH TEMPLE

- Breakfast at hotel.
- ❖ We will set out towards Chiang Mai, icon of the north, quiet and wooded city. On the route we will make different stops to visit a thermal area, where we can either soak our feet or boil some eggs, we will visit the **Tiger Sanctuary** (tickets not included) **Giraffe Woman Village** and **Doi Suteph**, a temple located on top of a mountain with spectacular views of Chiang Mai city. After the visit we will return to Chiang Mai and will have a small panoramic visit to the city. Transfer to the hotel.









#### **SUNDAY FEBRUARY 25th 2024**

# VISIT TO THE ELEPHANT SANCTUARY EVENING TOUR BY TUK-TUK

- ❖ Breakfast at hotel.
- ❖ Today we are leaving the city, we will spend about 90 minutes of travel until our arrival at the Elephant Sanctuary.
- ❖ Meeting with our English-speaking guide who will give us some brief explanations and we will learn a little more about the life of these "big ones" of the jungle, that can eat more than two hundred kilos of food and drink more than a hundred liters of water a day. We will dress in traditional Karen clothing and have our first contact with the elephants through bananas and sugar cane, they love it! We will be able to touch them, take photos, interact and learn a little more about them. Then we will go to the "spa"; area where we will learn about their skin treatments and we will also be able to bathe them in the river !! helping with their daily hygiene.









❖ In the afternoon we will enjoy the city of Chiang Mai and of some of its more than 300 temples, such as the Wat Chedi Luang, or "royal pagoda", which was the official temple of the Lanna kings; Wat Phan Thao, where stands out the golden carving of a large peacock above the main entrance, symbol of the Chiang Mai Kings. We will also visit the Wat Inthakhin Sadue Muang, which means temple of the navel of the city; thereafter we will be able to approach to contemplate the statue of the Three Kings, symbol of the city; and to end will visit Wat Phra Singh, which houses are highly revered 14th century Buddha image, donated by the King of Sri Lanka. Ater that, we will walk through the local market to discover the northern gastronomy; we will know the history of the battelment as it passes through the Tha Pae Gate, and the moat that is still preserved from the period when Chiang Mai was the cultural and religious center of the country.




